



PRINCETON FAMILY YMCA 2017 BIRTHDAY PARTY INFORMATION AND CONTRACT

The Princeton Family YMCA is a great place for your birthday party! We look forward to helping you celebrate. Each party is 2 hours long. The first hour of the party offers the special activity chosen by you from our options below, and the second hour will be free time in our gymnasium or group exercise room for any food, drinks, cake, or games you may wish to provide. Your child will receive a "Happy Birthday" t-shirt!

Please note that all refreshments, decorations, and invitations are the responsibility of the celebrating family, and are not provided by the YMCA.

We offer 3 activity themes for you to choose from:

SPORTS PARTY: Choose from the following sports-basketball, flag football, soccer, or t-ball/baseball! We provide a coach for the first hour of your party to run the games and assist the uninitiated. These parties take place in half of our gymnasium and are offered on Sundays from 2:30-4:30pm. *Includes 1 coach*

SPLASH PARTY: First hour is spent in our pool! We provide a dedicated lifeguard for the event and recommend that your guests arrive about **15 minutes early** to get changed if necessary. These parties take place in the pool (first hour) and our group exercise room (second hour) and are offered on Saturdays from 3-5pm or Sundays from 2-4pm. *Includes 1 splash attendant*

POOL RULES FOR SPLASH PARTIES: All children under the age of 16 wishing to swim in the deep end of the pool will be required to pass a swim test (freestyle one length of pool, tread water for 1 minute). Children ages 6-14 who pass the swim test may swim freely in the provided area, but must still have on-deck adult supervision. Children ages 6-14 who do not pass the swim test must wear a YMCA provided life jacket, have in-water adult supervision, and may only swim in the shallow end of the pool. Any child under the age of 6 must have a parent in the water with them at all times, regardless of the presence of the lifeguard. There are no exceptions for advanced swimmers. All children who are not potty trained MUST wear a swim diaper. Pool toys and inflatable flotation devices are not provided or permitted.

ZUMBA® PARTY: The Zumba® Kids program is the ultimate dance-fitness party for young Zumba® fans, where they can play it out and rock with friends to their own rules! A full hour of non-stop fun for the birthday honoree and friends, with dancing and games to Latin and international beats. These parties take place in our gymnasium and are offered on Sundays from 2 to 4. *Includes 1 Zumba® instructor*

PRINCETON FAMILY YMCA SPLASH PARTY INFO AND POOL RULES

2 lanes of the pool will be reserved for the first hour of your party. We recommend guests arriving 15 minutes prior to the start of the party in order to get changed and showered prior to entering the pool area. Swim testing will begin at 3:00pm on Saturdays and 2:00pm on Sundays for all children ages 16 and under wishing to swim in the deep end of the pool. The swim test is comprised of 1 length of strong freestyle and 1 minute of treading water with the head above the surface.

YMCA provided life jackets are required for non-swimmers (outside floatation devices are not permitted) and all non-swimmers must have an adult in the water with them at all times within arm's reach. All children who are not potty trained must wear a swim diaper. Other Equipment and toys are not available during birthday parties and we ask that no outside equipment be brought in. The facility pool rules also apply.

During the birthday party, you agree to abide by the pool rules and policies listed here and throughout the facility. Your party is not to exceed 25 people in the pool at any time. Any child requiring a floatation device must be accompanied by an ADULT at all times and this adult contributes to the 25 maximum.

The lifeguard is in charge at all times and may refuse access to the pool as well as enforce all rules and policies. The lifeguard has the right to ask any patrons to leave because of behavior or refusal to abide by the rules and policies of the pool and facility.

Children dependent on a floatation device MUST be accompanied in the pool by an adult at all times. Only 1 child may be supervised by 1 adult and must be no more than 1 arm's length away from the adult at all times.

Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.

All swimmers should wear a bathing cap or have hair tied back.

Anyone showing signs of communicable disease will be refused admission.

Persons with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, sores, or bandages will be refused admission.

Food, drinks and smoking are not allowed in the pool area.

Persons in street shoes are not permitted in the pool area. No street shoes are allowed on deck.

There is no roughness in the pool or pool area; no running on the pool deck or in the locker rooms.

Spitting or Spouting water is not permitted.

Jumping and diving is prohibited during birthday parties.

Starting blocks are not to be used during birthday parties.

The YMCA will provide life jackets for children requiring floatation devices. Inflatable floatation devices are NOT permitted. An ADULT must accompany them in the water at all times.

Toys are not permitted.

A swim test is required for use of the deep end. If the lifeguard is unable to do so, refusal of usage of the deep end may be enforced. The test consists of swimming 1 length competent freestyle with face in the water, arm strokes above water, a strong sufficient kick and ability to complete 1 full 25 yard length without stopping; the child must then tread water immediately after in the deep end for 1 full minute.

I agree to abide by the rules and policies listed above and agree to follow the lifeguards instructions at all times. I am hereby responsible for myself and my guests at the birthday party and agree to their adherence to the rules and policies provided in this contract.
